UNROOTED DORMANT GRAPEVINE CUTTINGS

Size 1. Standard Field/Nursery cutting. 4-10mm thickness below top bud. 1 cutting = 3 buds minimum.

Size 2. Bench grafting/Chip budding cutting. 4-10mm thickness below top bud, 1 cutting = 4 buds minimum. Size

3. Top working budding cutting. 5-12mm thickness below top bud, 1 cutting = 4 buds minimum

3. ORDER DEADLINE IS 2.00P.M ON 31st MAY ANNUALLY. LATE ORDERS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
4. Applicants will be advised of allocation estimates.

5. There is a limited supply of all varietal material, and it may be supplied on a pro-rata basis. As such, some orders may only be partially filled. WA customers will receive preference in the allocation process.
6. Distribution of material will take place at the time of cutting or, by the end August. (Contact admin@wavia.org.au for more details)
7. Cancellation of an order can be made up to 2.00pm on the 31st of May in which case all monies will be refunded. Cancellation after material has been cut for an order will result in monies not being refunded. Receipts and refunds will be issued by 30th September in the year material is cut. The receipt will be able to serve as a Tax Invoice for GST purposes.
8. Any Refunds from WAVIA to the applicant will be made by electronic transfer. Please supply bank account details on the Order form where indicated.
9. Interstate orders will only be considered from customers with a delivery address in Victoria or via a VINA accredited Victorian Grapevine Nursery. Additional fees and charges apply.
